Construction Committee

This committee serves as an advisory board to the construction management staff, relating to standard construction policy, house designs, methods of construction, jobsite safety, construction materials, bidding policy, the definition of Habitat's housing principles, and any other construction-related issues not determined by the construction management staff. This committee also oversees the selection and acquisition of lots.

Executive Committee

The Executive Committee shall consist of the elected officers of the Board, and the immediate past President(s) of the Board if this person is still a Director. If the past president(s) is not still a Director, then an additional member may be elected to the Executive Committee from the Board at large. This Committee shall oversee the Executive Director of the Corporation, and shall perform the functions of the Board of Directors in the routine management of the affairs of the Corporation. The meetings shall be presided over by the President(s), and the actions of the Executive Committee shall be recorded by the Secretary and shall be presented to the Board of Directors at the next Board meeting for acceptance.

Family Selection Committee

This committee works with the Family Services Coordinator and is responsible for recruiting and selecting the families for whom the homes will be sold as well as being a liaison between Habitat and local social service agencies. This committee advises the staff on any other matter needing input.

Finance Committee

This committee is led by the Treasurer of the Board and monitors the finances of the Affiliate and the ReStore on a monthly basis.

Fund Development Committee

The Fund Development Committee is responsible for developing a fundraising plan and setting goals, organizing annual fundraising campaigns, coordinating special events, and promoting the Affiliate.

ReStore Committee

This committee works with the Operations Manager and helps set policies and procedures, discusses new, innovative directions for conducting store operations, and develops marketing strategies. The committee is the liaison between the Habitat Board and the ReStore.

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
